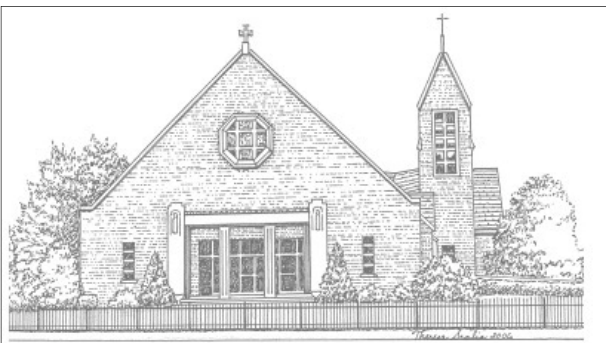

Religious Education Registration

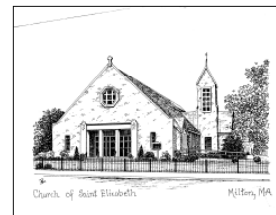
Families *currently enrolled* in our Religious Education Program are asked to return their updated registration forms to the Religious Education Office a.s.a.p.
