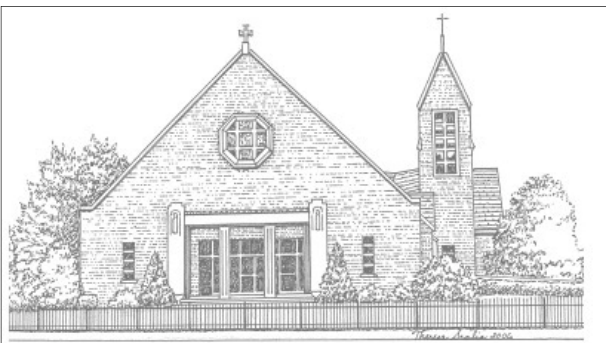

50 + Club— Women's Club— Pro-life Committee— St. Vincent DePaul Society— Eucharistic/Hospital and Homebound Visitors.

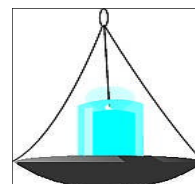

Families *currently enrolled* in our Religious Education Program are asked to return their updated registration forms to the Religious Education Office a.s.a.p.

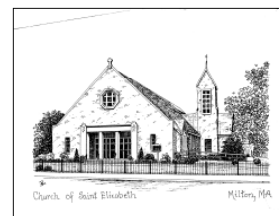
Families who are *new* to our Religious Education Program in the fall are welcome to pick up a registration packet and return it a.s.a.p.
