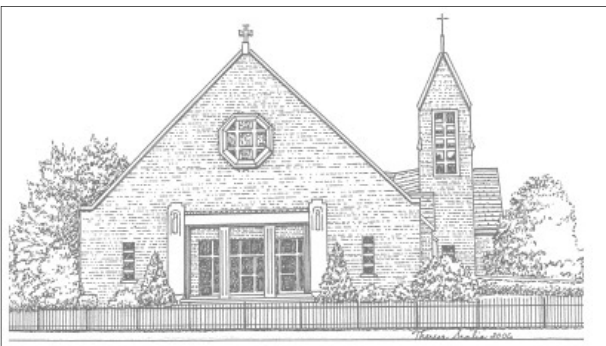

Dear Parishioners,

*As we continue our discussion on the New Roman Missal, I would like to answer the following question.*

**Can we start using text approved by the bishops immediately?**

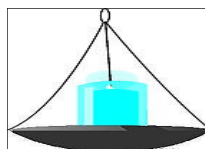
The translation of the Missale Romanum can not be used in the celebration of the Mass until the complete text is confirmed by the Holy See. Once the translation receives the recognition, the USCCB will establish the first day on which the new translation may be used. Use of the revised text requires preparation and catechesis for both priest and the faithful.

When the time comes to use the text in the celebration of the Mass, priests will be properly trained, the faithful will have an understanding and appreciation of what is being prayed, and musical settings of the liturgical text will be readily available.


